


# Age 2 Years - Developmental Milestones

By 2 years of age, children often have drastically improved gross motor and language skills as compared to 18 months. By 2 years of age, children are often able to stack a tower of 6 blocks and can also walk up and down stairs 1 step at a time. Most 2 year olds are also able to stand on their tiptoes, throw a ball overhead, as well as run and jump. Children's language skills also increase drastically between 18 months and 2 years of age. By 2 years, usually  $\frac{1}{2}$ 0 of their speech is understandable to a total stranger and children are also capable to following a 2 step verbal command. At two years, children also take part in parallel play, which is described as children playing adjacent to one another but not directly playing with one another.

Toddlers at this age should be able to say two-word sentences, and have about 200 words in their vocabulary.

### Half of Speech is Understandable

Half of Speech Heard

Children's language skills also increase drastically between 18 months and two years of age. By two years, usually half of their speech is understandable to a total stranger.

## **Parallel Lines**
